



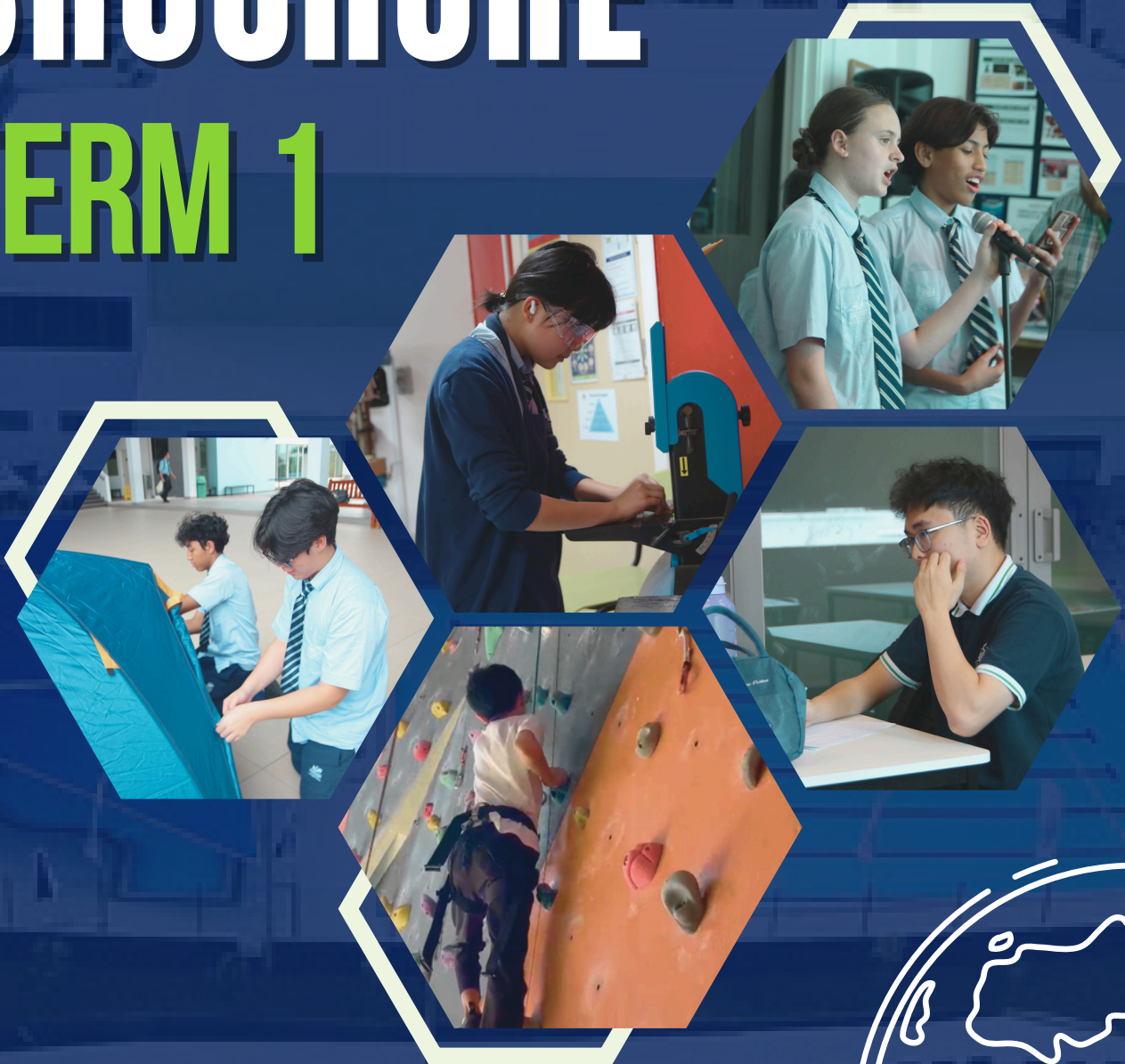

C

Chess Club (Year 7 to 13)

Through puzzles, games, and analysis, join Chess Club and improve your thought process of students and become a high-level player capable of competing in the big leagues!

Whole School Choir is a joyful and collaborative space for students from Year 4 upwards and even staff, to come together and celebrate music. This ECA encourages teamwork, confidence, and a love for music, while providing opportunities to showcase talent at school events and assemblies.

Creative Writing (Year 7 to 13)

Students can practice free creative writing based on given prompts/themes of the week.

Cricket (Year 4 to 8)

Join our Cricket ECA to develop your skills, teamwork, and love for the game. Learn the fundamentals and improve your technique. It is a great way to stay active, make new friends, and have fun.

Crocheting (Year 8 to 12)

Learn how to crochet and knit in a fun, friendly space. We'll create simple handmade items like keychains, scrunchies, coasters, and more. Some of our crafts may be sold at school events to raise money for charity or support school projects. It's a great way to be creative, relax, and make a positive impact!

D

Darts (Year 10 to 13)

Want to improve your mental mathematics? Want to do quick multiplications, additions and subtractions whilst having fun? Darts might just be the ECA for you then! Learn the rules and different types of games, ranging from 301 to round the clock. You never know, you might get a 180!

Duke of Edinburgh (Year 10)

The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award is a non-competitive, internationally recognized program designed to encourage young people to develop positive skills and lifestyle habits. The Award is about personal challenge and development and is adaptable according to each participant's interests and abilities. The strength of the Award is our ability to readily partner with other youth organizations through leader development and resource sharing.

Note: Requires you to be 14 years old and above

E

ECO Club (Year 4 to 8)

Students will take part in initiatives such as planting, creating eco-friendly crafts, and raising awareness about environmental issues within the school community.

ECO-Guardians (Year 4 to 11)

A combination of gardening ECA and eco-club, with the aim to develop the eco-garden and produce eco-friendly/sustainable products from school waste and eco-garden produce. This ECA should be supervised by Year 12/13 ESS students.

Embroidery (Year 9 to 13)

This is a free ECA; however, students are required to bring or buy their own materials for the project. Embroidery is a traditional yet creative craft where students learn the art of decorating fabric using needle and thread.

Football (Year 10 to 13)

We will practice drills to develop skills and play small sided games. Open to students keen to develop their football skills and understanding of the game.

This club is perfect for those who love crafting, enjoy hands-on activities, or want to contribute to reducing waste by giving discarded materials a new life.

Further Pure Mathematics (Year 11)

(Invite only) To extend their mathematical thinking beyond the standard curriculum.

German for Beginners (Year 7 to 13)

The German for Beginners ECA is a fun and interactive program designed for students who are interested in learning the basics of the German language and culture. Open to all beginners, this club provides a relaxed and engaging environment where students can develop their language skills.

IGCSE 0607 Exam Preparation (Year 11)

(Invite only) The IGCSE Maths Support ECA is designed to help students strengthen their understanding and confidence in Mathematics as they prepare for their IGCSE examinations. This supportive environment offers students the opportunity to revise key topics, receive guidance on homework, address any gaps or misconceptions, and practise exam-style questions. It also serves as a quiet and focused space for students to consolidate their learning and seek assistance where needed.

ISB Big Band (Year 6 to 13)

ISB Big Band Rehearsals. Any new students are welcome, but should have a good level of performing skills on their instrument to ensure inclusion.

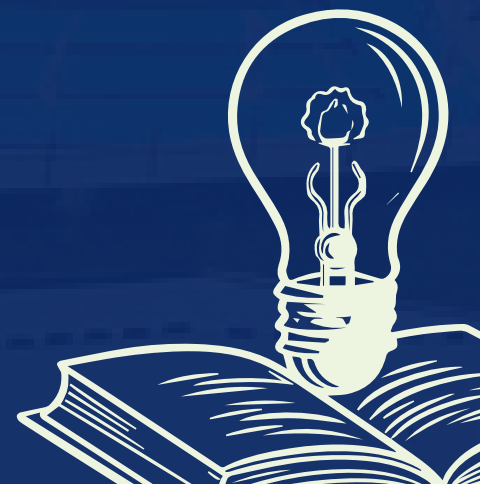
